Notice regarding what to do in the case of a North Korean missile crisis

Thank you for your continued support for Toyohashi and the Toyohashi Board of Education. Due to recent developments, we will be covering the course of actions to be taken in case of a missile crisis. If a government warning (J-Alert) has been issued regarding a possible missile crisis, the schools will take actions detailed below. We hold the safety of all students as our highest priority. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

If Aichi prefecture is outside the affected area, students are to attend school as per usual.

If the J-Alert has been issued for Aichi

Alert time	Action	Following actions
Before school	Stay at home	 If missile lands outside of Japanese territory ⇒ presume normal activities If missile lands in Japanese territory ⇒ Stay inside home until a following alert instructs you otherwise
During school	Follow emergency instructions at school	Once safety is confirmed, resume classes
On the way home from school	Evacuation	Evacuate swiftly as according to standard evacuation procedures. (See back "Actions in case of missiles flying to Japan" for what students are taught in schools for emergencies and evacuations.)
